The Ministry had two Departments: Department of Urban Development & Department of Urban Employment & Poverty Alleviation. From 27th May, 2004, the Ministry has again been bifurcated into two Ministries, viz: (i) Ministry of Urban Development and (ii) Ministry of Urban Employment & Poverty Alleviation. The Ministry of Urban Development is headed by Shri S. Jaipal Reddy, the Minister for Urban Development. The Minister joined the Ministry on 19th November, 2005. Shri Ajay Maken is Minister of State for Urban Development. He joined the Ministry on 30th January, 2006.
